The examiner gives eight TPR instructions to each candidate. This part tests the understanding and following spoken instructions.

Part 2 Reception II

The examiner shows a set of three pictures to each candidate and describes one of them. The candidates take turns in listening to three different sets of instructions. The candidates are only expected to point to the correct answer. This part tests understanding the spoken instructions.

Part 3 Spoken Interaction I

Sınav içeriğinde; kişisel soruları cevaplama, gösterilen nesnelerle ilgili soruları cevaplama, bir nesneyi tasvir etme, sınav esnasında dinlediği kısa bir hikâye ile ilgili soruları cevaplama ve gösterilen resimlerden (her bir resim ile ilgili bir ve üç kelime arası) kısa bir hikâye oluşturma olmak üzere 5 bölüm vardır. Öğrencileriniz dinlediğini anlama ve ilgili sorulara cevap verebilme ve dili kullanabilme alanlarında değerlendirilir.

Birinci dönem sonunda yapmayı teklif ettiğimiz sınav sonucunda, eğitim kurumuna öğrencilerin bireysel performansını gösteren güçlü ve güçlendirilmesi gereken alanlarının detaylı raporlaması sunulur. İkinci dönem sonunda yapmayı teklif ettiğimiz sınavda eğitim kurumuna aynı raporlama sunulduğu gibi, ayrıca her öğrenciye IEC tarafından başarı sertifikası verilir.



ASSESSMENT

International Exam Centre (IEC) Very Young Learners qualifications are exams with unique approach and a fresh look to assessment. They are designed to evaluate the English language skills of Kindergarten, Primary 1st and 2nd graders. Very Young Learners Exams mainly focus on Listening and Speaking skills and they are aligned with the acquisitions of Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd Grade. All candidates will receive a certificate showing their detailed performances along with their respective points and reports. International Exam Centre is recognized and associated with **Quality English**.

Pass with Distinction: When candidates achieve distinction in an exam, that means they have shown extraordinary abilities beyond their exam level. Hence, they will receive a certificate showing their achievement and stating that they are ready for the next exam.

Pass or Pass with Merit: When candidates achieve pass or pass with merit in an exam, they will receive a certificate stating that they have demonstrated abilities aligned with the exam they have taken.

Low Achiever: When a candidates' performance is lower than the level of the respective exam, the candidates will still get a certificate but it will state that they have demonstrated abilities one level below than their respective exams.

General ability	The candidates can understand very simple and utterances such as 'This is a book, 'I like my school' and attempt to use it with somewhat intelligible pronunciations.	The candidates can recognize the letters of the English alphabet. They can pronounce these letters along with their names and simple words.
Social and School Life	The candidates can understand very simple expressions of communication while responding to these expressions in a very simple way. They can also listen and repeat some words.	The candidates can read short words and the names of some objects, such as animals or toys. They car speak with simple sentences about themselves of their families.

What do the stars mean?

For each skill, the candidates are awarded between one to five stars. If the candidates get two stars, that means they have many things to improve in that respective skill. Candidates who receive three stars still have some things to improve but they also answered a lot of the questions correctly. Finally, candidates who are awarded five stars had an exceptional performance and answered almost all of the questions in a correct way.





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
